We are thrilled to announce that over 70 singers ó a combination of the Old North Festival Chorus, the Old North Senior Choir, and our professional soloists ó are rehearsing for the upcoming **Lenten Choral Concert**, and we enthusiastically invite your attendance and support!

Our choral centerpiece will be Dan Forrestøs stunningly beautiful *Requiem for the Living*, which was originally programmed in 2020, but abruptly halted due to the Covid-19 pandemic. As described on Danøs website, õA Requiem, at its core, is a prayer for rest ó traditionally, for the deceased. The five movements of *Requiem for the Living* (2013), however, form a narrative just as much for the living, and their own struggle with pain and sorrow, as for the dead.ö

As we continue to adapt to the return of live performance, we are so proud to début this choral masterpiece at Old North with members of the church and friends from surrounding communities! Our performance takes place on Palm Sunday, April 13, 2025, at 7:30pm in the sanctuary at Old North; soloists for this performance include: Holly Cameron, soprano; Rebecca Kenneally, mezzo-soprano; Kevin Hayden, tenor; and Andrew Scoglio, baritone.

Our performance marks the beginning of Holy Week and a long-held tradition at Old North to offer members of the Marblehead community a program of musical reflection by candlelight. Our concert is free and open to the public, though a free-will offering will be gratefully accepted.

This very special performance is supported, in part, by a combination of the Music Patrons and Festival Chorus Funds at Old North Church as well as voluntary contributions collected at the door. Concert and production expenses ó including artist fees for our singers and the Old North Festival Orchestra ó are estimated at \$15,000; if you would like to help defray the costs of our Lenten Choral Concert, we would be most grateful for your contribution in any amount.
